Content

 - Requirements regarding professional and school qualifications
 - Working conditions (working hours, health and safety, employment contracts, pay, etc.)
 - Rights and obligations, work ethics
 - How to deal with unemployment
 - (Guided) tour of a company, excursions
- Application training
- Life in Germany
 - Geography of and political life in Germany
 - Norms and Values in everyday life and working life
 - Health service
 - Education system
 - Social system, insurances
 - Dealing with money
 - Healthy living, shopping etc.
 - Social life, clubs, culture
 - Drug and debt prevention
 - Sporting activity, health provision
 - Conflict management, rules for groups and behavior

- competence assessment in an operation company
- enhancement and deepening of knowledge of the German language through practical application
